

Below are the ingredients you will need.

C: Good question. Hmm. I guess a couple of things because I took a total of 9 flights during this trip (In



How to Handle a Tyre Blowout

vour car becomes unsituation. A driver's reaction can make all the difference in how the situation plays out. Therefore, you need to know what to do in such 1. Do not brake suddenly times.

To appropriately deal with a tyre in a situation to be in; understandblowout, you will need to know what it sounds and feels like. There are typically three sounds, which may vary: one, is a loud bang



of the tyre popping which rings through the car. The second is the whooshing sound of air leaving the tyre. Lastly, there may be repeated flapping of deflated tyres 2. Keep a firm grip on the steering hitting the road.

Now let's talk about the feel. If either one of the front tyres blows

hen a tyre bursts, it takes out, your car will pull to that side and the steering will feel heavier. On the other hand, if your car controllable. This can be a fright- sways from side to side, a rear ening and potentially dangerous tyre has blown. In either case, you should keep calm and do the fol-

A tyre blowout is a nerve-wrackably, this may be your first instinct. However, hard braking will further imbalance and destabilise the vehicle. This can be of great consequence.

> To keep as much balance and control of the car as you can, maintain acceleration initially by gently easing off your throttle. You must decrease your speed gradually without braking if you want a steady halt.

Note that you should immediately turn on your hazard lights to alert oncoming cars.

The car may pull in the direction of the burst tyre but ensure you maintain control. Keep the wheel as straight as possible. Also, do not try

to swerve in the opposite direction too quickly as that can be dan-

With a blown-out tyre, the car is very unpredictable and imbalanced. A sharp yank of the steering wheel can result in a somersault. The best you can do is keep your hands on the steering and the car straight.


Bonus: It is recommended to drive with both hands on the steering. It makes controlling the car in an emergency easier.

3. Identify an appropriate place to stop

When your car has slowed down, you can lightly engage the brakes and safely pull over to the side of the road. Do not stop in the middle of the road. You should also avoid stopping on soft sand as this could make changing your tyre difficult (if the jack is not firm on the ground).

Once you are in the clear, you can change the tyre or call your mechanic to help. You should also remember to stay protected with our Flexi- or Comprehensive car insurance plans, which pay to fix or replace your car in the case of an accident or theft.
